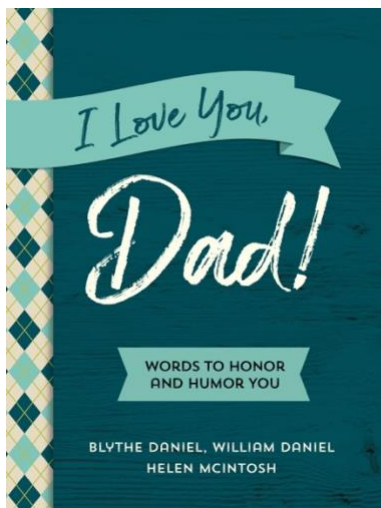


HONORING THE DAD IN YOUR LIFE
